Last year through the generosity of the Companions and Sisters, we were able to assist an International water project in Uganda for children with special needs. This is an accomplishment for which we can be very proud in making a difference.

This year we chose a local project: assisting immigrant families through Women Partnering. Women Partnering is one of the ministries sponsored by the Sisters of St. Francis.
